The Committee of the Croydon Astronomical Society can have up to ten members. Of the four executive officers (Chairman, Vice Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary) two remain in post for the second year of a two-year term, so eight posts are open for election.

In 2019 the Chairman and Treasurer are due for election and will be appointed at the first committee meeting after the AGM.

Any member can be nominated to stand for election, supported by two other members as proposer and seconder, by giving written notice to the Secretary. The date by which nominations must be received is **Friday 12th April** (not a RRS meeting day).

Committee members are also Trustees of the charity and so must not be disqualified from acting as a trustee according to the requirements of the Charities Act 1983. Details of the requirements are available on the Charity Commission website. Trustees must be aged at least 18 years on the date of election.

In the event of there being more nominees than posts, a ballot of members will be held. Members may submit a written manifesto which will be circulated with the ballot form in the event of a ballot. The manifesto can be written on the reverse of this form.
